## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All rules and regulations must be observed to avoid disqualification.
2. Only driver and one pit crewmember will be allowed in the pit area.
3. Entry fee \$40.00 (no refunds). This covers driver and pit member.
4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the fair grounds.
5. Participants must be 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
6. All drivers must supply their own car. Entries limited to one car per race. You may enter more than race on one or both nights of racing.
7. Front doors **MUST** be painted white for car number. We will supply car numbers.
8. All drivers, mechanic and car must be in the staging area (2) two hours before starting time. The starting time is 6:30 PM.
9. Any stock hardtop automobile or station wagon ***except Chrysler Imperials*** will be allowed. No trucks, jeeps, hearses, ambulances or 4 wheel drive vehicles are allowed.
10. All glass, including windshield, plastic, chrome must be removed from the car before entering the fairgrounds. All plastic grills must be removed
11. Tires must be stock size. 4-ply only with no inner liner. No snow or truck tires. Tires can only be filled with air, no fluids. All wheel weights must be removed.
12. A maximum of (5) five gallons of gasoline will be allowed. Gas tanks may be moved to the trunk, but the entire rear seat or a firewall must be in place. The tank will not be allowed in the driver's compartment. Only unleaded gas allowed.
13. Only one stock battery will be allowed and must be in the engine compartment or securely fastened and covered in the driver's compartment.
14. No reinforcements of any kind will be allowed. The only exception will be the driver's side door.
15. Standard exhaust systems must be as intact as possible, at inspection. Not permitted are headers, stacks, custom manifolds, etc.
16. Do not weld or bolt the hood or trunk lids down. Use wire. All doors must be welded shut or securely tied. If the driver's door opens during the race, both the car and driver will be disqualified.
17. A 12 x 15 inch hole must be cut into the center of the hood
18. All fan blades must be removed. The only exception will be if your car is equipped with a slip fan clutch blade or fan shroud.
19. Safety belts and helmets are required. The car must be equipped with a shoulder harness and a lap belt; both must be in place. You can be disqualified for the removal of either the helmet or seat belts during the race. ***All drivers must wear long pants, long sleeve shirts and full shoes and socks.***
20. Driver must maneuver forward and backward. No deliberate head on collision or deliberately ramming the driver's door. This may cause disqualification.
21. A time limit will be set by judges, if the driver does not hit a live car within the time limit it may be disqualified.
22. Arrangements must be made for the removal of all cars from the grounds by the owner. The Fair Society will not be responsible for any vehicles left at the close of the evening activities.
23. All insulating type material must be removed from the underside of the hood.
24. Lebanon Valley Auto Racing, Inc., as the event promoter, reserves the right to reject any and all registration applications, and to prohibit any individuals from participation in the demolition derby which it determines, in its sole and absolute discretion, to be in the best interest of the proper conduct of the demolition derby event.
