RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entries are accepted on a “first come” basis and are open to anyone age 12 and older. Entrants 12 years old and younger will be eligible to show, but will not receive passes. All entries must be on official entry forms and include FULL payment of entry fees at time of entry.
2. 4H members may enter the Open Class. Separate entry must be submitted to the Open Show Superintendent and accompanied by current pullorum test, if applicable.
3. Current Pullorum test only will be accepted. NPIP forms are not permitted except under specified.
4. Please make checks payable to **Columbia County Fair**.
5. All entries will be individually inspected by show superintendent upon arrival for coop-in. Any birds showing signs of ill health, unworthiness or poor condition will not be accepted. *No refunds on any entries that are withdrawn by entrant or rejected for ill health, unworthiness or poor condition. NO EXCEPTIONS.*
6. We CANNOT allow substitutions after publication of the rules and regulations in the premium book and Fair web site.
7. If a class specifies “any”, please be descriptive. *Wrong class entry may result in disqualification. Please ensure entries are under correct class number.*
8. All exhibits for premiums must be entered in the name of the owner for at least 30 days prior to show date and under the care of the entrant or entry will not be judged.
9. Birds shall be entered as:

Class A. Cock – Male hatched prior to January 1, 2011

Class B. Hen – Female hatched prior to January 1, 2011

Class C. Cockerel – Male hatched after January 1, 2011

Class D. Pullet – Female hatched after January 1, 2011

10. Entries will be received Tuesday, August 30th from 12:00 noon to 9:00 PM.
11. Entries shall be handled by superintendent and judges ONLY.
12. Only the clerks and judges shall be present for judging.
13. All entries must remain in place for the duration of the show and cannot be removed until after 9:00PM on Monday, September 5th unless prior arrangements have been made or premiums will be forfeited.
14. Entrants may advertise any For Sale **ONLY** entered birds, after judging takes place. Birds may not be released until after 9:00 PM Monday, September 5th. Entrants will be responsible for the sale of their own birds.
15. The superintendent will provide the best possible care for the birds, but assume NO responsibility for loss or damage.
16. Any falsification OR misconduct will be reported to the management.
17. Judges will be governed in accordance with the American Poultry Associations Standard of Perfection or the American Bantam Associations Bantam Standard as applicable. The judge’s decision will be final.

NOTE: ALL exhibitors will be requested to assist the Exhibit by working a short shift during the Fair or prior to the Fair during cleaning and setup of the Exhibit.
