1. All entry forms must be postmarked not later than Friday, August 20, 2011. They can also be hand delivered to the fair office until September 4th.
2. Employees of Ginsberg's Foods, the Agricultural Society and its Board of Directors are not eligible to enter.
3. Professional chefs as well as home-cooks are welcomed.
4. All Entries must be accompanied by the name, address and phone number of the cook, the local source of ingredients, and a copy of the recipe.
5. Entry items will be accepted for judging on Monday, September 5, at 12:30 P.M.
6. Entries may be any kind of dish, from soup and appetizers to salads, entrees, and desserts.
7. Entries must be fully cooked and ready to be served. There is no cooking or refrigeration or set up facilities available.
8. The equivalent of eight (8) portions should be provided for judging.
9. The criteria for judging is **TASTE * PRESENTATION * ORIGINALITY**
10. Judges results will be announced at 3:30 PM at the North Gate Stage. All cooks must be present to win the Ginsberg's Foods "Morton A. Ginsberg Award".
11. Your serving pieces may be picked up after 3:30 PM Monday, September 5. The Agricultural Society is not responsible for return of or damage to containers or dishes.
