RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. For the best collective exhibit by Granges, Youth and Pomona Granges of farm and garden produce, fruit, baked goods, vegetables, canned goods, grains and grasses, poultry, dairy products, honey, sewing and needlework.
2. Names or place cards indicating the name of the Subordinate Grange may not be placed on exhibit until after the judging.
3. Building to be closed while exhibits are being judged.
4. Granges intending to exhibit must notify the committee before August 1st.
5. All work on exhibits is to be completed for judging by 10:00 AM Wednesday, the opening day of the fair.
6. Each grange will furnish material and erect its own stand
7. Daily inspections of Subordinate Granges will be made and a maintenance bonus will be awarded at 12 noon, on the last day of the fair.
8. Scoring of all exhibits will be on magnetism, Freshness of Produce: Vegetables-20 points, Flowers-20 points, Fruits-20 points, Baked Goods-20 points and Display Appearance-20 points, for a total of 100 points each day of the fair.
9. Perfection of produce will be judged on all exhibited items listed. Pomona and Subordinate Grange exhibits may use part or all items listed, with a minimum of 3 items.
