1. Tallest Sunflower PLANT

Leaves are not necessary, please REMOVE. The tallest (SINGLE HEAD) plant will be measure from the bottom of stalk (soil line) to the bottom center of the seed head. Cut the plant from the base of stalk. Only the stalk including Full seed head, if head is disconnected, it's a disqualification.

World Record 30'1"

2. Largest Sunflower HEAD

Heads should be cut from stalk. The measurement will be taken across the sunflower head containing a **FULL** (at least 95%) of seeds. The judges will determine if the sunflower head qualifies, if seeds are missing.

World Record 32 1/4"

3. MOST Sunflowers on ONE Stalk

Only open/partial open flowers (half or more) count! World Record 837 flowers
