3. Entries must be received for judging **NO LATER THAN Saturday, August 24th - NOON**.
4. No exhibitor shall be involved in commercial beer, wine or cider making or use the services of a commercial facility.
5. Open to any amateur wine, beer or cider maker, 21 years or older, who lives within 100 miles of Chatham NY.
6. All entries become the property of the Columbia County Agricultural Society.
7. Awards will be presented upon completion of the competition.
8. The decision of the judges is final.
9. **Pick Up:** All EMPTY bottles can be picked up on or after September 2, 2019
