ENTRY FEES

Classes \$10 per class, Class 12 & 25 \$15 per class

There is no pre-entry required.

Rules

1. Loss, injury or damage to horse, rider, owner, coach, groom, spectator or other individuals is in no way the responsibility of the Columbia County Fair Management or the Horse Show Committee.
2. A Certificate of a Negative Coggin's Test, performed in the current or previous calendar year, must be presented before exhibitor numbers will be issued. All equine entering any NYS County Fair must be immunized against Rabies. Vaccine must be administered at least 14 days prior to the arrival on fairgrounds. Vaccination Certificated from your Veterinarian must accompany each equine. Equines not meeting these requirements will be rejected from the premises.
3. Riders under 18 years of age must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted.
4. Age is calculated as of December 1st of the previous year, as per USEF rules.
5. NO DOGS ALLOWED ON HORSESHOW GROUNDS for the safety of our riders, horses, and spectators.
6. All entry fees must be paid prior to receiving exhibitor numbers. Post-entries must be made a minimum of 2 classes ahead, to avoid confusion. There will be no refunds given for scratched classes. A \$30 fee will be charged for returned checks.
7. The fair treasurer will pay all premiums by check, which will be mailed to exhibitors to whom the premiums have been awarded, within 45 days from the last day of the fair. As the Society is required by law to make an early detailed report to the State Department of Agriculture and Markets, all checks issued for premiums must be presented within 30 days from the date of issue.
8. Numbers must be worn by exhibitors in the ring at all times. No charge for numbers.
9. Only judges and those having duties to perform shall be allowed in the ring during judged competition.
10. Tickets to enter the Columbia County Fair will be issued 2 per rider with paid entry fee.
11. The show committee may add/combine/cancel any class as warranted. If 4 or fewer horses are entered in class 12 and 25, it will become a winner take all.
12. Schooling – Controlled free schooling will be permitted between 7am and 8am in the main ring. There will also be a designated schooling area to use throughout the day.
13. No martingales, tie-downs, or dressage saddles permitted.
14. No stallions will be permitted on the show grounds in order to protect the safety and comfort of other competitors.
15. Poor sportsmanship or cruelty will result in immediate action by the show committee and may include disqualification and forfeiting any prizes won.
